Before the NDA is designated, an analysis would be required that shows that affordable housing would not occur without the exemptions. The analysis would also be required to show the potential future tax revenue that may result from the development.

OASBO joined with OSBA and BASA for interested party testimony in the House Ways & Means Committee on November 18th. We continue to advocate for additional "guardrails" to be implemented related to the types of housing that would qualify, as well as requesting board of education approval for the exemption at any exemption percentage.

OASBO provided written testimony on HB 450 on December 1, 2020 in the Senate Local Government, Public Safety and Veterans Affairs Committee similar to the testimony provided in the House. As we previously highlighted, school treasurers are already required by law to turn over information, etc., when they leave office. HB 450 makes reference to that statute for school treasurers as we had suggested, but still adds a new requirement for a Certificate of Transition.

One point of interest is regarding that statute from current law. ORC Section 3313.28 still refers to the treasurer being required to turn over information related to teachers. Since we no longer possess/collect those records, we indicated to the AOS that the section needs to be amended. The AOS agreed and that change is reflected in HB 450.

Considering the overwhelming support in the House for this bill, it is likely that the Senate will pass HB 450 before the end of the year. As outlined in the legislation, the AOS office would then work with us and others to determine the requirements that must be included in a Certificate of Transition.
