

FY21 Budget Reductions

FT STEM Lab/Title I Math/Elective position:

- Stem Lab sections redistributed (& less sections due lower enrollment)
- Title I Math sections redistributed to math teachers (2 sections per teacher)
- Elective model restructured
- FT Title I Literacy teacher:
 - Title I ELA sections redistributed to ELA teachers (2 sections per teacher)

FY21 Budget Reductions

FT Music teacher:

- Elective model restructured
- Science and SS teachers created and began teaching 1 elective section

FT to PT Latin/French Language teacher reduction:


Due to reduced student requests.

No reduction in student supports and a reorganization of elective offerings.

Band, Orchestra, FOA, & Chorus still offered.

World Languages: Latin


- Review:
 - Decreasing student enrollment in Latin
 - Majority of middle schools only offer 2 languages**
- Latin will be discontinued as middle school offering 21-22



The Story Behind the Numbers: Academic Needs

- Number of Students with IEPs (Individual Education Plans):
 - SY 20-21: 63 students (14.5%)
 - SY 21-22: 80 students (19%)
- Number of Students with 504 plans (Accommodations):
 - 27 students (6%)
- Number of Students enrolled in Title I classes:
 - Literacy Enrichment: 59 students
 - Math Foundations: 58 students

Student Motivation: Hybrid



- My level of motivation has not been impacted by learning in a Hybrid Model.
- My level of motivation has increased while learning in a Hybrid Model.
- My level of motivation has decreased while learning in a Hybrid Model.
- I am in Cohort C, so I don't have much asychronous learning.

Titan Time: Academic & SEL support


Hybrid Students were asked to identify how they used Titan Study. They could endorse multiple uses.

- 1. To complete schoolwork (92.8%)
- 2. To de-stress & relax (62.3%)
- 3. To quietly socialize with friends (51.1%)
- 4. Make-up missed tests and quizzes (50.5%)
- 5. To get help from my teachers (41%)
- 6. To organize my materials (40.8%)



Student Stress Level

Has learning in a Hybrid Model impacted your stress level? 321 responses



Many students are reported high levels of stress: 45.5%

SEL Supports: Guidance

Grade Level Guidance Counselors

- Teach 8 class sections (2st Century Skills: 1x/per 6-day cycle)
- Student caseloads
 Grade 7: n= 203
 Grade 8: n= 230
- 2 weekly Kid Day meetings to track student functioning
- 1 weekly administrative meeting
- Manage all aspects of 504 plans
- Support grade level transitions
 - Elementary -----> Middle
 - Middle
 High School



SEL Supports: School Psychologist

School Psychologist:


- Complete psychological & cognitive testing
 - 40 completed evaluations 19-20
- 4 Kid Day meetings/ per week
- 25 counseling students/week per IEPs & 504s

Follow up meetings for student attendance/tardy concerns

- 2-5 daily student check-ins
- 1-5 unplanned student 'drop-ins' daily (average)
- Crisis assessment and response, as needed



Category	Description	Notes
Social Emotional	1.0 Social Worker	Increase surround care social emotional supports at PCMS from .5 to 1.0 to keep pace with rising needs
Academic	1.0 Special Education Teacher	Due to increase in special education needs in 21-22
Academic	Phase out Latin as a middle school world language offering	Beginning in 21-22, students would have 2 world language choices: Spanish & French
Academic	Open Science Ed curriculum work	Teacher PD: Summer 2021
Academic	Humanities: Common Unit review with social justice lens	Teacher PD: Summer 2021
