

6. It should show you what sites are blocked


- If Google Classroom is not showing up correctly.

- If you can not see the attachments for the assignment, click “View Assignments”




- If you get the error “Class not found”. Logout of all google accounts on your device.




- If there are too many assignments and you can not tell which ones you have completed.


1. Go to Home or 3 lines next to the class name.
