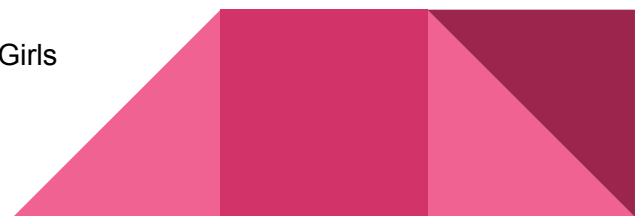

Who Takes Honors Courses?

Honors courses provides motivated students the opportunity to learn with increased academic depth.

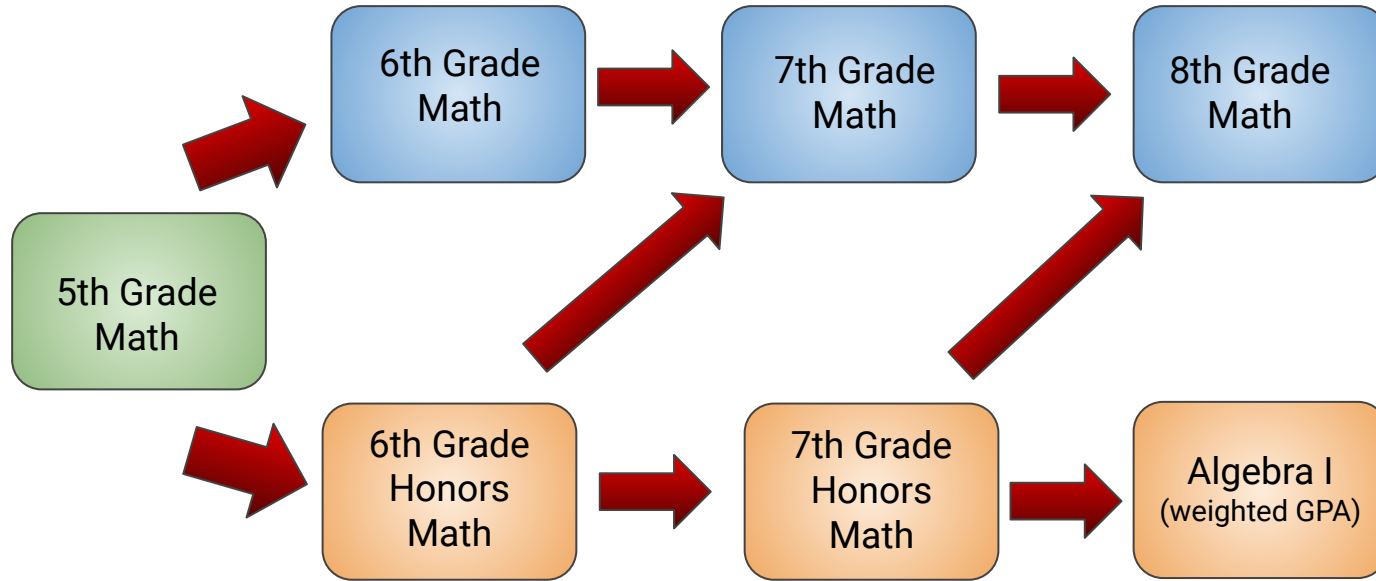
A student must meet 2 of the 4 following requirements to register for any Honors course:

1. “Masters” on the Reading (RLA/Social Studies) or Math (Math/Science) STAAR assessment
2. 85% or higher for the year in course for the previous grade
3. Gifted & Talented identification
4. Previous content teacher recommendation

Additionally, students must be willing to work hard and complete assignments on time. Students must be comfortable with challenging material and comprehend concepts at a faster than average pace.

Honors RLA Summer Assignment

Students selecting to take Honors RLA for next year will be required to complete a summer project. The student will read a book, choices will be provided, and create a One-Pager for the selected book. The project **MUST** be turned in on the first day of school, August 16, 2022.

(Students new to the district will have 3 weeks to complete the project once school begins.)

PE vs Athletics

PE

Students acquire knowledge and skills for movement that provide the foundation for enjoyment, continued social development through physical activity, and access to a physically-active lifestyle.

Athletics

Designed for students that are interested in pursuing competitive athletics during 7th grade.

Boys: Cross-country, Football, Basketball, Track, and/or Tennis

Girls: Cross-country, Volleyball, Basketball, Track, and/or Tennis



Additional Required Courses for ALL 7th Graders

Teen Leadership - 1 semester

- Learn leadership, professional, and business skills
- Develop a healthy self-concept and build healthy relationships
- Understand the concept of personal responsibility
- Skills in public speaking and problem solving

Health - 1 semester

- Learn about health behaviors that will safeguard students' health
- Factors in the environment that impact self-health, families, and communities
- Refine critical thinking skills to avoid unsafe situations

STAAR Tests and Scheduling

- ❑ If a student does not meet expectations on the Reading and/or Math STAAR in 6th grade OR is not on grade level for Reading and/or Math, the student will be scheduled into an Academic Enrichment class.
- ❑ According to state law, we are required to provide students with additional support and instruction to promote future success.
- ❑ **Academic Enrichment will take the place of the elective.**
