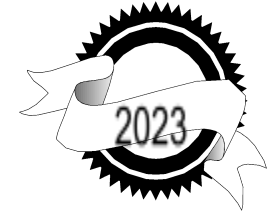

It is best if you do not wait until Friday, March 24<sup>th</sup> to email scholarships. Unexpected things happen (snow days, illness, pandemics, etc.). Turn your scholarship applications in early to avoid missed deadlines.

## **Applications**

### **BERKSHIRE TACONIC COMMUNITY FOUNDATION (BTCF) (Deadline March 15)**

Any WRHS graduating senior who resides in the Central Berkshire Regional School District and plans to continue his or her education beyond high school may file a BTCF application. This application requires a copy of your FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR), an unofficial transcript, a letter of recommendation and a personal statement. The application is available at <https://berkshiretaconic.org/>. All applicants will receive notification of their scholarship decision in the summer. These scholarships include the Garrett Francis Collins & Josephine Goodwin Collins Scholarship Fund as well as the Zenas Crane Fund.
