How your oral health and organ transplant are connected**



GUM DISEASE

Anti-rejection medications make it harder to fight off bacteria, which can lead to gingivitis (early gum disease), which causes red, swollen or bleeding gums. Gingivitis can progress to periodontitis (severe gum disease), which can destroy your jawbone and lead to serious infection beyond your mouth.



DRY MOUTH

Antirejection medications suppress the immune system and cause dry mouth, which can lead to mouth sores, gum disease and tooth decay.



ULCERS

Antirejection medications also make the mouth lining more susceptible to sores that can make chewing, speaking or swallowing painful.

How the reimbursement process works

1. Enroll

To get reimbursed, you first have to enroll in the Cigna Dental Oral Health Integration Program® by either:

- ▶ Going to **myCigna.com**, selecting Coverage > Dental and filling out the registration form online
- ▶ Calling the number on the back of your Cigna ID card and asking for a mailed registration form

2. Submit your claim

If you visit an in-network dentist, they'll send us a claim directly. If you see a dentist not in the Cigna network, you may need to submit the claim yourself. Then we'll review it and refund you for eligible dental services in about 30 days.
