Graduation vs. College Requirements

Graduation

- 1 year of world language
- 2 years of math
- 1.5 years total of fine art & practical art
- 2.5 years of PE (including one quarter of health)

College

- 2 years of world language (3 recommended)
- Through Algebra 2 in math (4 years recommended)
- 1 year of fine or performing art

Types of Colleges



- **University of California (UC)**
Examples: UC Davis, UC Santa Cruz
- **California State University (CSU)**
Examples: San Jose State, Chico State
- **Private Colleges/Universities**
 - Range in size, admissions requirements, speciality
Examples: Santa Clara University, Boston College
- **Out-of-State Public Universities**
Examples: Oregon State, University of Texas
- **California Community Colleges (CCC)**
 - Get General Education requirements & transfer, an Associate's degree, or Career Certification

California Public College Systems

CSU System (23 Campuses)

Eligibility Index:

1. 10 & 11 GPA
2. ACT or SAT
3. A-G classes beyond the minimum

Four-Year College Tests

PSAT aka *The Practice SAT*

- Hoping to offer it October 2021 (11th grade)
- Qualifying test for the National Merit Scholarship

SAT Reasoning

- Critical Reading & Math (No writing portion)

ACT

- English, Math, Reading, Science Reasoning, Writing (optional)

Take SAT and/or ACT during **spring** of Junior year
Re-test after studying

Many colleges are in the midst of changing their test policies. Check college websites to find the most up-to-date information on the ACT/SAT requirements.

**Currently, the UC's do not use the SAT/ACT for college admissions, but for the Class of 2023, the CSU's will be requiring it for admissions (this could change).*

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: When is the lottery to possibly add a 7th class?

A. The Lottery generally takes place the second week of school in the Fall, after it is determined which classes still have space. An announcement will be made through School Loop to enter the lottery.

Q. How do I apply for summer school?

A. Complete a summer school application when it becomes available in late March/early April. School Loop will announce when summer school applications are available.

Q. Can I take PE Health in summer school this summer?

A. Complete a summer school application when it becomes available. Spots for PE Health generally are determined by seniority.

Q. If I will be playing a sport, which start time should I select?

A. Choose early start, periods 1-6, so that you don't miss 7th period when participating in afternoon games/meets.

Q. How many hours of community service do I need? How do I complete these hours during distance learning?

A. 20 hours are required for graduation. For online community service hours opportunities, visit [here](#).
