College Admissions Test Requirements

SAT & ACT

- <u>University of California (UC's)</u>: will not consider SAT or ACT scores when making admissions decisions
 - If you choose to submit test scores as part of your application, they may:
 - be used to determine your eligibility to fulfill minimum requirements
 - for course placement after you enroll
- <u>California State University (CSU's)</u>: has temporarily suspended SAT/ACT scores in determining admission eligibility for Fall 2022

minimum GPA is 2.5; math in senior year is recommended

- Private/Out-of-State Universities: testing policy varies by campus; check the institution's website for current info
- California Community Colleges: DO NOT require SAT/ACT

- Classes are available in the morning and afternoon

- Students can earn 30 credits per year


