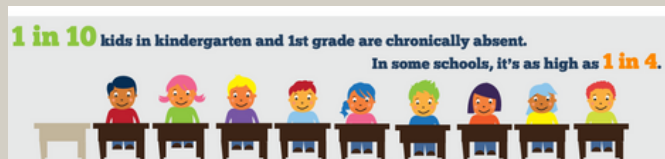

Instructional priorities

Reading, writing, and discussion in all content areas to provide cohesive instruction and opportunities for productive struggle.

Provide effective feedback to students that affirms what they have done well and guides them toward academic improvement and achievement of learning goals.

Study and leverage student-level data on a regular and consistent basis to identify learning opportunities and create plans to address them.

Use rubrics as tools to provide a shared language with clear guidelines and expectations to provide a measure, adjust, and evaluate learning.

Read By Grade 3 Law

The Michigan Legislature passed a law that requires schools to identify learners who are struggling with reading and writing and to provide additional help. The law states that third graders may repeat third grade if they are more than one grade level behind beginning with the 2019-2020 school year and not being proficient on the M-Step.

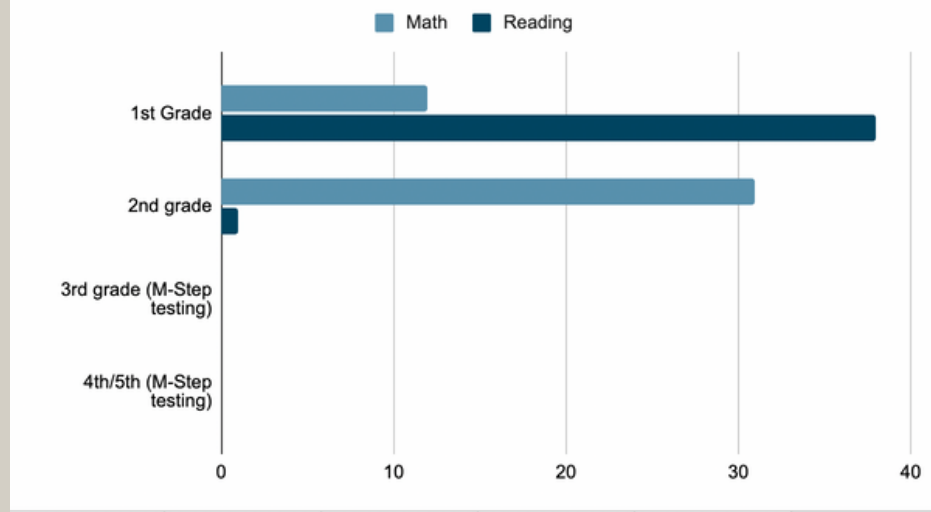
