About HHS

Heritage High School, the third comprehensive high school build in the Perris Union High School District, opened in August 2007. HHS is WASC Accredited and is a member of CollegeBoard. The school site replaced farmland in the rural Romoland area. Much of the the student population comes from families who have relocated to the growing area. We have 2452 students enrolled for the 22-23 school year. The student body is culturally diverse with a population that consists of:

- 73% Hispanic
- 12% White
- 8% African American
- 4% Asian/Filipino
- 72% Socio. Disadvantaged
- 16% Special Education
- 13% English Language Learners

Heritage High School assigns letter grades using a 4.0 system. All credit classes are included in computing the grade point average and class rank. Class rank is based on the weighted GPA.

Heritage High School has a partnership with Mount San Jacinto Community College and offers the following UC/CSU transferable college classes through dual enrollment:

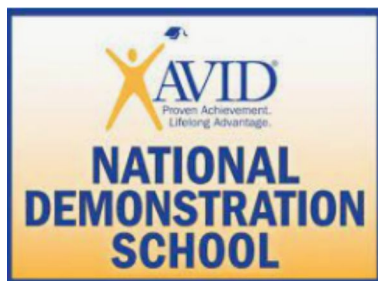
