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We are off to a great 2023 with our workshops hosted by Orange Coast College. OCC allowed us to utilize their facilities free of charge to create opportunities for students to learn together in a performance venue.

This year we resumed our workshops on a smaller scale. Our workshops this year focused on Middle School Vocal and Secondary Guitar. On both January 10 & 11, we had 80 students each day enter the stage and rooms of OCC to learn new music, techniques and learn the value of playing together on a district team. We thank our clinicians Dr. Kellori Dower (Dean of Cypress College Fine Arts), Mr. Wesley Martin (American Boys Chorus of Daniel Monaghan (Private America), Guitar Teacher and Grad Student at Cal State Fullerton) and Giovanna Mera (Private Guitar Teacher/ Calstate Fullerton Alumni) for imparting their knowledge and time to our students.

At the December 6, 2022 NMUSD school board meeting, **OC Supervisor Katrina Foley** spoke to the board for the approval of receiving funds from her office through the American Rescue Act.

\$150,000 was awarded for instruments that will serve our student K-12 in instrumental music. An additional \$40,000 was awarded to Costa Mesa High School for the purchase of a new piano and items for the theater.

Through these funds, schools will receive instruments that are difficult to receive and maintain. The goal of these funds were to purchase high quality instruments for a sustainable program

We thank the supervisor for her continuing support of our arts programs.

### **NMUSD Arts Commission**

The NMUSD Arts Commission began on November 9, 2022 to discuss the implementation and actions towards our strategic arts plan. We began our evening reading and evaluating the action plans we have set at the end of the school year. We then looked for those items that were not being addressed and discussed how we could fill in those gaps.

The diversity of opinions and viewpoints will be needed to bring a comprehensive view of our arts programs and how to enhance them. Now that we have legislation for categorical funding such as Prop 28, it is important to have both the long range and short range views for our programs.


