- NMUSD's Early Learning Program will bring together programs across early learning and K-12 to ensure every four-year old child has access to a quality learning experience the year before kindergarten.
- School district plans are due to school board by June 30, 2022.

The plan for 2022-2023 is to begin the expansion of TK with straight TK classrooms.

- Beginning in the 2022-2023 school year, Transitional Kindergarten will be offered at home schools for schools who have TK enrollment of at least 10 students.
 - If a school site does not have at least 10 TK students enrolled by early August, their TK students will be offered a TK program at a satellite school within their zone.
