# **District of Innovation**

- The District of Innovation concept, passed by the 84<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session in House Bill 1842, effective immediately, gives traditional independent school districts most to the flexibilities available to Texas' open-enrollment charter schools.
- To access these flexibilities, a school district must adopt an innovation plan, as set forth in the Texas Education Code chapter 12A.

# What can a DOI do?

- Potential benefits of becoming a District of Innovation include:
  - Local control: Districts decide which flexibilities best suit their local needs.
  - Customization: Districts can create an innovation plan for a level of schools (e.g., only high schools) grade level, or a single campus.
  - Autonomy: Districts must submit a district of innovation plan to the commissioner of education, but approval is not required.
  - Flexibility: Districts will have the flexibility to implement practices similar to chart schools, including exemptions from mandates such as:
    - School start date
    - Class-size ratios
    - 90% attendance rule
    - Teacher certification
