VIDEO PRODUCTION INSTRUCTOR

Function:

Responsible for the instruction of Video Production classes and related practicum experiences involving the application of video production and technology skills. Activities may include school-related events and projects outside the classroom.

Relationship:

Reports to high school principal, Director of Career and Technical Education and community advisory committee.

Qualifications:

- Washington State Career and Technical Education certification in Communications Technologies V100100, or ability to be certified
- Demonstrated skills in student leadership development
- Strong technology education background preferred
- Radio/television production capabilities preferred
- Ability to work closely with Career and Technical Education advisory committee

Typical Duties & Responsibilities:

- Develop and use materials that meet the course competencies and Essential Academic Learnings (EALR's) as approved by the district
- Plan student laboratory problems that provide students with simulated industry-type experience
- Work with appropriate student/youth leadership activities, i.e., Skills USA or TSA (Technology Student Association)
- Work with a community advisory committee
- Order supplies, instructional materials and equipment for the program
- Develop and maintain a program budget following CTE, district and building guidelines
- Work cooperatively with other technology teachers, including Tech Prep articulation with Olympic College
