## AMERICAN SIGN LANGUAGE INSTRUCTOR (CTE)

### Qualifications:

1. Standard ASL teaching certificate or Washington State Career and Technical Education certification in Sign Language Interpretation/Interpreter, or ability to be certified.
2. Demonstrated ability to work with students from various backgrounds and academic abilities.
3. Demonstrated ability to motivate students and successfully employ effective teaching methods.
4. Genuine desire to work with all students to help them succeed.
5. Demonstrated skills in student leadership development.
6. Ability to work closely with Career and Technical Education advisory committee.
7. Ability and desire to work toward development of Small Learning Communities preferred (i.e., Health and Human Services).

### Function:

The instructor will have the opportunity to teach American Sign Language I and II using standards and competencies in a curriculum framework from “ASL: Signing Naturally,” “A Basic Course in American Sign Language,” and “Deaf Heritage.” ASL I introduces students to ASL language (signing), grammar, cultural behaviors and social relations as well as students’ expressive and receptive skills. ASL II is a continuation of ASL I and satisfies college entrance requirements.

### Duties & Responsibilities:

1. Must be proficient in American Sign Language and have the ability to stay current with ASL and deaf culture trends.
2. Have curriculum development skills.
3. Understand competencies related to the Sign Language Interpretation/Interpreter program and understand functional support of the essential academic learnings.
4. Work cooperatively with World Language and CTE teachers and a citizen advisory committee.

### Relationship:

Reports directly to the principals and the Director of Career and Technical Education.
