JOB DESCRIPTION

Registered Physical Therapist

Function:

The main role of the Physical Therapist (PT) is to provide specific physical therapy services **and consultation** to qualifying students. The PT will be supervised by the Director or the Assistant Director of Special Education in compliance with the policies of North Kitsap School District.

Relationship:

The PT is responsible directly to the Director of Special Education or the Assistant Director of Special Education.

Qualifications:

1. Professional certificate in Washington State as a Registered Physical Therapist
2. Experience with children, ages 3-21 years old, in public schools.
3. Washington State Physical Therapist Educational Staff Associate (E.S.A) or ability to obtain the ESA.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities:

1. Perform fine motor, gross motor, range of motion, self-help activities and/or other relevant physical therapy duties with students.
2. Assist in evaluation, planning the IEP, and attend relevant IEP staffings and meetings.
3. Consult on, or construct, specific adaptive equipment for students.
4. Consult with school staff on design and/or modification of school settings, positioning, assistive technology, and instructional materials.
5. Perform evaluations and document student progress.
6. Maintain confidentiality of information.
7. Attend in-service training sessions where appropriate or required.
8. Attend regularly scheduled OT/PT peer group meetings

Marginal Duties & Responsibilities:

1. Perform other duties as assigned.

Evaluation:

Performance of this job will be evaluated in accordance with provisions of Board Policy on Evaluation of Support Services Personnel.
