Athletic Medicine Instructor

Function:

Provide basic classroom instruction in athletic medicine studies.

Relationship:

Reports to the high school principal and the district's vocational director.

Qualifications:

1. Bachelor's degree necessary, masters preferred.
2. Certification by the National Athletic Trainer's Association preferred.
3. Washington State Vocational Trades & Industries Sports Medicine certification required.
4. Washington State teaching certificate preferred.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities:

1. Gives basic instruction and advice to students and athletic staff in the prevention and care of injuries, conditioning programs, and selection, care, and fitting of protective equipment.
2. Teaches/supervises student trainers and schedules the student trainers for coverage at athletic contests and practices.

Marginal Duties & Responsibilities:

1. Other duties as assigned.
