

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

The following regulations govern transportation services:

1. The Board shall at all times maintain general supervision and control over the transportation program. The Board shall delegate the actual responsibility for direct control to the Superintendent or person designated by the Superintendent and Board to be responsible for transportation.
2. Buses used for student transportation shall meet all Ohio State Construction Standards for school buses.
3. School buses shall not exceed the posted speed limit and/or a reasonable, safe speed for road, weather, and/or traffic conditions.
4. Students living more than one mile from the school attended are entitled to transportation. Students must be at the bus stop at least five (5) minutes before the bus is due to arrive.
5. Students with physical handicaps that make walking difficult or dangerous, living any distance from school, are entitled to transportation.
6. Special and different walk limits shall be set for students within the one-mile limit if terrain, age of student, traffic, walk-space, weather, or student's health have bearing on his safety.
7. Bus stops shall be limited, where possible, so that students from several homes, within a half-mile radius, can meet at a central point safely for group pick-up.
8. The Transportation Supervisor shall have the authority to designate collection points.
