

ELIGIBILITY ZONES FOR PUPIL TRANSPORTATION

The Board provides transportation for resident elementary students in grades kindergarten through 8, who live more than one mile from school, and for all students with physical or mental disabilities that make walking impossible or unsafe. The transportation of high school students is optional.

The administration designates and the Board approves areas of residence from which students are provided transportation to schools. The Board may create exceptions to the established eligibility zones.

Resident students attending a joint vocational school are provided with transportation to the program from the high school to which they are assigned.

The Board authorizes the staff responsible for administering the student transportation program to require student identification as a prerequisite to riding a school bus when this is deemed necessary.
