

PROFESSIONAL STAFF DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE (LPDC)

The Board of Education directs the Superintendent to assure the establishment of a Local Professional Development Committee (LPDC) that is in compliance with Ohio law and any applicable terms of the negotiated agreement between the Board of Education and the Gallipolis Education Association.

The Board hereby establishes a six-member district-wide committee, comprised of two administrators (a building principal and the Superintendent/designee) and four teachers (one from each of the remaining buildings). The LPDC shall develop policies, forms, and procedures to oversee and review written individual professional development plans for the renewal of credentials for employees of the Gallipolis City School District.

The Superintendent shall report periodically to the Board of Education on the operation of this committee, and on progress which staff members are making in fulfilling their professional development plans.
