- B. **DairyMax Cause for Applause (Sandra Castro)** – Rodney Freeman was named Dave Campbell’s Texas Football Assistant Coach of the Week. Currently, Physical Educators from 44 campuses in Klein ISD have completed Step One of the Fuel up to Play 60 program. Klein Child Nutrition has implemented a grab and go cart services at Klein Forest High School to provide more meal service location which has resulted in more students eating breakfast each day.
