MCI NEW INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS - VACCINATIONS

1. In order to support our student population professionally, and from the moment they step foot onto our campus, it is expected that they are fully vaccinated in accordance with the State of Maine Immunization Requirements for School Children. <https://www.maine.gov/dhhs/mecdc/infectious-disease/immunization/family/documents/immunization-requirements-for-school-children.pdf>
2. It is recognized, however, that there will occasionally be extenuating circumstances that prevent an international student from meeting all immunization requirements prior to arrival in the United States of America. Therefore, and in accordance with MRS Title 20-A, §6355. ENROLLMENT IN SCHOOL, any student arriving at MCI without a required vaccination must provide:
 - a. **Written assurance.** The parent provides a written assurance the child will be immunized within 90 days by private effort or provides, where applicable, a written consent to the child's immunization by a health officer, physician, nurse or other authorized person in public or private employ.
 - b. **Medical exemption.** The parent or the child provides a written statement from a licensed physician, nurse practitioner or physician assistant that, in the licensed physician's, nurse practitioner's or physician assistant's professional judgment, immunization against one or more of the diseases may be medically inadvisable.
3. In the case of 2.a. MCI will arrange for immunization that will be billed to a student's medical insurance, with an additional school administrative fee of \$100.00 per vaccination.
4. Any student present on the MCI campus will be enrolled in classes.
