The board did a walk-through of the Interior School grounds.

The meeting was called to order by Board President Ross Block.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Board President Ross Block.

The Consent Agenda included the following items: to approve the agenda, to approve the minutes of the December 12<sup>th</sup>, 2022, and December 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022, meetings; to approve the financial report; to approve the bills as presented. SUPERINTENDENTS REPORT: Mr. Hermann asked the board to start planning for negotiations. The legislative session begins soon and will end late March. The governor will be giving her state of the state address tomorrow and she is projected to give a 5% increase to education. He asked the board to think about attendance center sizes and staff needs. The COVID staff funding will remain for the 2023-2024 school year. Special education student numbers will remain the same for next year, but the needs have increased.

PRINCIPALS REPORTS: Mr. Lukens gave a second semester update. He also read the student update written by a senior this month on how the year is going. He also reported that finals went well given they had to be done after the break. Discussion was held on finals exemption, currently there is no exemption tied to attendance. When present remote attendance goes away, the finals exemption will revert to being tied to attendance.

Mr. Nemecek gave a mid-year MAPS update, there wasn't a huge increase or decrease in scores. Evaluations will be in full swing next week; he tries to complete three per week. He then went on to report on the Title I review that went well.

BOARD REPORTS: Building and Grounds, Mr. Hermann reported that December was a slow month at the building site. Snow has been removed and they have been busy, still looking at a move in date of summer 2023.

ACTION ITEMS: Paul Roghair moved to set the school board election date for April 11, 2023, and combine with municipal elections, motion was seconded by Dawn Rasmussen and carried.

RESIGNATION: Paul Roghair moved to accept the resignation of Brandy Knutson effective at the end of the 2022-2023 school year and advertise for the open position, motion was seconded by Mark Williams and carried.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Rebecka Roghair moved to go into executive session at 3:36 PM per SDCL 1-25-2(1) for personnel matters, motion was seconded by Eric Wilmarth and carried. The board came out of executive session at 6:01 PM.
