STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUSES AND AT BUS STOPS

- 2 Student transportation is a privilege not a right. Students are required to conduct themselves
- 3 on school buses and at bus stops in a manner consistent with established standards for
- 4 classroom behavior.
- 5 The school principal may suspend or revoke the riding privileges of students and/or take other
- 6 disciplinary actions for students who are disciplinary problems on the bus. Parents/guardians
- 7 of children whose behavior and misconduct on school buses or at bus stops violate the Student
- 8 Code of Conduct or otherwise endanger the health, safety, and welfare of other riders shall be
- 9 notified that their child/children face the loss of school bus-riding privileges and/or other
- 10 disciplinary actions.

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- 12 If a student's riding privileges are suspended or revoked, the student's parents/guardians are
- 13 responsible for seeing that the student gets to and from school safely.
- 14 The bus driver is responsible for maintaining the orderly behavior of students on school buses
- and shall report misconduct to the student's principal and provide a copy of the report to the
- transportation office.
- 17 This policy shall also apply to students using alternative means of transportation provided by the
- 18 school division.
