Dear Moore Public Schools (MPS) Community,

We greatly appreciate our state's leadership of Governor Stitt and State Superintendent Hofmeister who have made the decision to close all Oklahoma schools for two weeks after Spring Break. **As of now, schools will resume on Monday, April 6, 2020.**

For clarification: students and staff are not permitted in school facilities during this time. Until school resumes – no classroom instruction and/or other school related activities will occur.

Our state leaders' decision was made in an abundance of caution to safeguard our students, staff, and families, and to prevent possible spread of COVID-19. We appreciate our custodial staff who continue to deep clean all school facilities throughout Spring Break.
