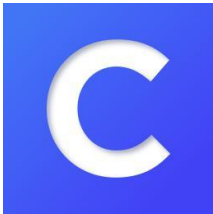




# Parent and Student Technology Guide

Your student will be using a variety of technology tools to support their education experience. The MPS Educational Technology department wants to share a few details with you on some of the basic tools your student’s teacher may be using on a daily basis.



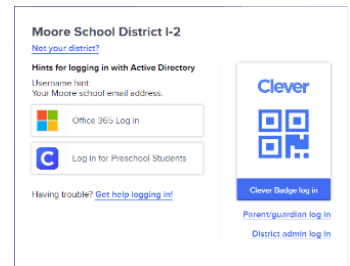
## Clever

Clever is an easy way for students to access all their learning applications. It is their single sign-on portal where they only have to remember **one username and password**, or use a **Clever Badge**, to log into all their learning applications.

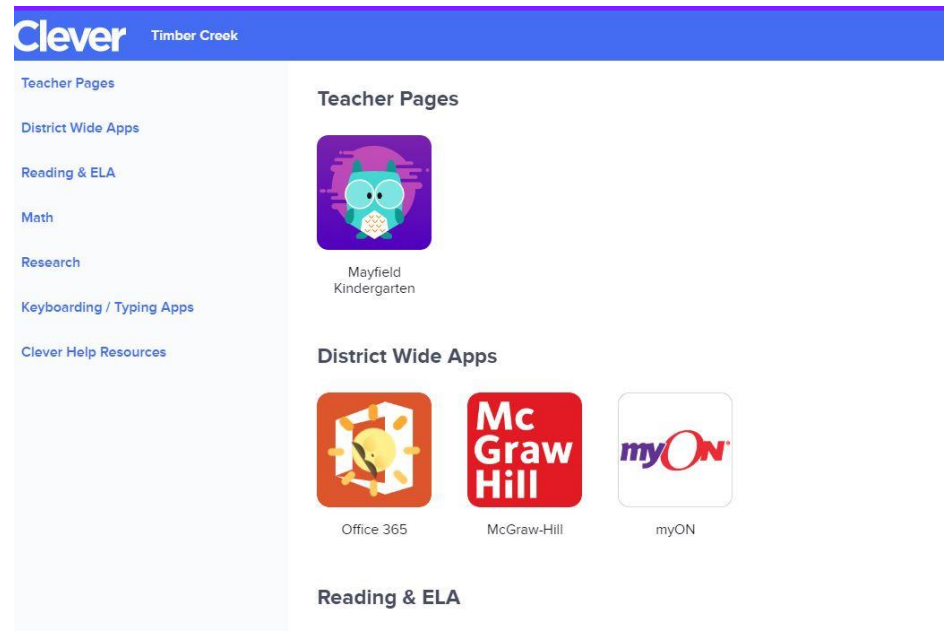

1. Students will find the Clever login icon by selecting the flyout menu in the upper right corner of our MPS websites (circle with three lines).
2. When the login page appears, students may either scan their Clever badge, or they can select the Office 365 Log in option and sign in with their Moore schools’ email and password. \*Preschool students may use the preschool sign in option if they do not have their badge with them.
3. Students will see their teachers’ pages, which include any resources their teachers want to share with them, and they will see District Wide apps that are available to them as well as apps that pertain to specific subject areas (textbooks, digital databases for research, etc.).

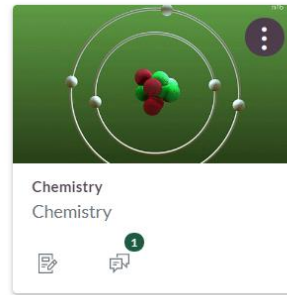
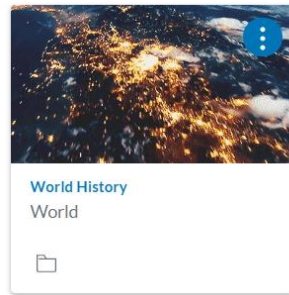
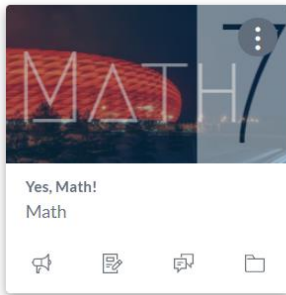
## Canvas

From learning to read to reading to learn, Canvas supports teachers in improving student achievement for everyone, from the littlest learners to college-bound seniors and beyond. Our teachers will be using Canvas as their classroom platform where they can post lessons, assignments, quizzes, discussions, and announcements.

1. Students will login to Canvas through Clever. **It is recommended that you use the Google Chrome app or Google Chrome browser.**
2. When you log in to Canvas, the first thing you see is the Dashboard. It provides a high-level overview of your current courses.
3. Card View displays a course card for each of your courses. New courses automatically display on the dashboard.

4. Each card can include four clickable icons for Assignments, Announcements, Discussions, and Files. Badges indicate new or unread activities.
5. The dashboard also displays the Sidebar.
  - a. It includes a To Do list to help you keep track of assignments and other activities. You can click any assignment name to view the assignment, and you can click the remove icon to remove the assignment from the sidebar.
  - b. The Recent Feedback section displays the latest comments from instructors or peers on previously submitted assignments.

6. Parents will login to Canvas by selecting the Canvas icon from the flyout menu in the upper right corner of our MPS websites (circle with three lines). Parents: please read through the parent information on the lower part of the login page to find out how to obtain a pairing code, so you can view your child's Canvas account.

### Infinite Campus

Infinite Campus is the system where your student’s attendance, grades, and data are stored. Parents can download the Campus Parent App to view updates on their student’s IC account.

1. To login to Infinite Campus, go to [www.mooreschools.com](http://www.mooreschools.com) and scroll down to either the “For Our Parents” section. You will select the “Parent Portal” link.
2. You will need a special code in order to view your student’s IC account.
3. You must visit your school’s secretary with a valid ID in order to obtain the code for your student’s account.

You will need to download the Zoom program/app onto your device if it is not on there already.

\*The menu options will vary depending on if you are using a browser or the app and depending on what type of device you are using.

Seesaw is a program for Moore Public Schools’ PreK-6<sup>th</sup> graders where students can share what they are learning and save their work in a digital portfolio. Teachers can invite parents to be a part of Seesaw, and they will only see their child's work. Your student will access Seesaw through Clever.

Parents will access Seesaw using the Seesaw Parent and Family app.

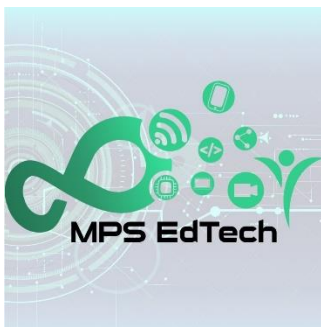
