- Meeting Call to Order - 8:15 am

 - [FTE](#) -
 - Francine discussed the FTE which was received in March. For the 2023-24 school year there would be 2 rounds of Kinder and 5th; 3 rounds of 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; 1 PreK learning teacher and 1 enrichment teacher.
 - There have been 58 new enrollments after school started. Lowest numbers of enrollment were in Kindergarten. The 3rd and 4th grades are limited term positions. The 2nd grade will be a regular position.
 - Last moment space changes are difficult - ventilation and other issues have to be thought about. So, planning from before always helps. Last year, Mrs. Legg's classroom had to be converted at the last moment.
 - Creekside will have a reading interventionist for next year. Creekside would like to have our librarian full time, however the number of students in K-5 must be 350. Francine will ask for more library para time if the number gets close to 350.
 - As far as the Math Interventionist is concerned, Francine said that once the cost of everything else is worked out, she will know for how many hours the interventionist will come in.
 - School Budget
 - Francine said that the school budget has been allocated for 369 students for the next school year. This will be adjusted again after the October enrollment counts.
 - The total allocation is \$38,510. The bulk of the money, about \$7000 is used for copier rental and usage. Approximately \$3000 is spent on substitute teachers, \$5000 for office supplies, \$6000 is for custodial expenses. Teachers get \$200 for extra supplies for the classroom, etc. As part of 'Principal's' budget spending, Francine pays for 'Seesaw,' purchasing books, helping teachers with their supplies, etc.
 - The money collected by Creekside Parent Organization (CPO) through various events is also immensely helpful.
 - Rob Price, Assistant Superintendent, Operations, assured that he could arrange for making payments for any extra furniture Creekside may need, for example, extra chairs for the cafeteria.

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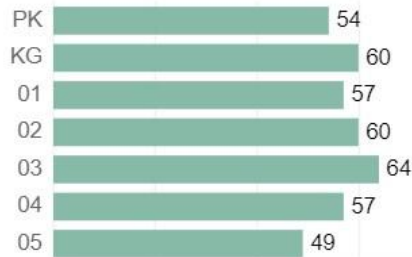

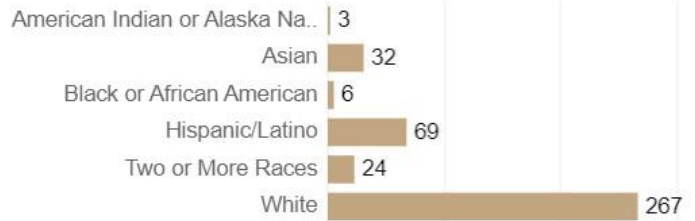

- Completed the Reading to End Racism in classrooms recently
- Hosted a film screening of “This is (Not) Who We Are” here at Creekside on Friday 4/15. The youth equity council joined for a panel discussion afterward and it was very impactful. Francine stressed that the Youth Equity Council highlighted Black ‘Joy’ and achievements and not just about the history of slavery.
- DEI is hosting one or two events this spring for mixed race and BIPOC families. The goal of these is to provide an opportunity for connection for families to meet other mixed race and BIPOC families in the school.
- DEI is sponsoring an Indigenous Dance performance (all-school assembly) during the morning of Friday 5/19. One of our Creekside students dances in this group.

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- DEI submitted and received additional funding; funds will also support positive and inclusive posters/ visuals in the LCs.
- Francine pointed out that this month was also celebrated as 'Arab American' month and 'Autism Acceptance' month.
