



Following recommendations of the District's Bond Advisory Committee, the Eanes ISD Board of Trustees has called a May 6 bond election for voters to consider maintenance and efficiency projects, including safety and security upgrades, maintenance and refurbishment projects, and the purchase of new technological devices for students and staff.

In addition to the work proposed across the district, the following projects are specific to West Ridge Middle School:



### WEST RIDGE MIDDLE SCHOOL

- Facility refurbishments including flooring, wall finishes, ceilings, etc.
- Access control and exterior door prop alarm safety upgrades
- Door-locking device safety upgrades
- Exterior notification safety system upgrades
- Modernize front office circulation desk area
- Library modernization
- Classroom furniture replacements
- Art kiln replacement
- Storage in classrooms that lack built-ins
- Fire alarm replacement
- LED pole lighting replacement for turf field
- Kitchen HVAC unit replacement
- Replacement of fan-power box HVAC units in band area
- Special ed and teen-skills kitchen equipment upgrade
- Roofing replacement (partial)
- Front parking lot/bus lane reconfiguration improvements
- Tennis court resurfacing
- Basketball goal replacements
- Fine arts uniform, instrument and equipment replacements
- Athletic uniform replacements
- Athletic equipment replacements
- Elevator modernization

**THE BOND ELECTION WILL HAVE NO IMPACT ON THE EANES ISD TAX RATE, REGARDLESS OF THE OUTCOME. EANES ISD VOTERS WILL CONSIDER THREE PROPOSITIONS:**

#### PROPOSITION



Proposition A (\$117.773 million) would authorize safety and security upgrades, physical repairs and refurbishments at every campus — as well as energy-efficiency projects, network replacements, new learning management systems, library modernization and more.

#### PROPOSITION



Proposition B (\$2.411 million) would authorize refurbishments at Chaparral Stadium including pole lighting replacements, track surface replacement, bleachers, handrails and video board replacement.

#### PROPOSITION



Proposition C (\$11.245 million) would authorize replacement of student and staff digital devices, as well as devices in labs, classrooms and offices.
