PPS / PES

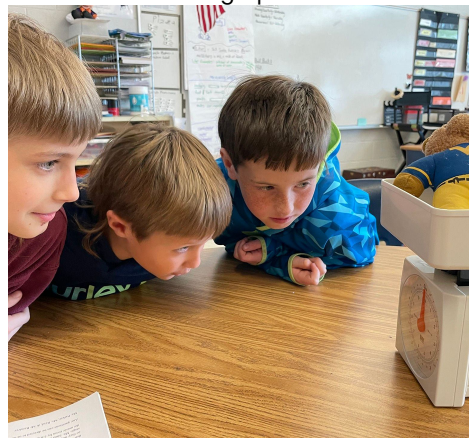
PPS has been busy with their Mad Science Assembly and Color Run event (with PES). Thank you again to our PTO!
