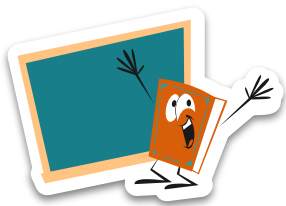

- *Title funds are spent appropriately*

PARENTS, TEACHERS, STUDENTS, ADMINISTRATORS, COMMUNITY MEMBERS

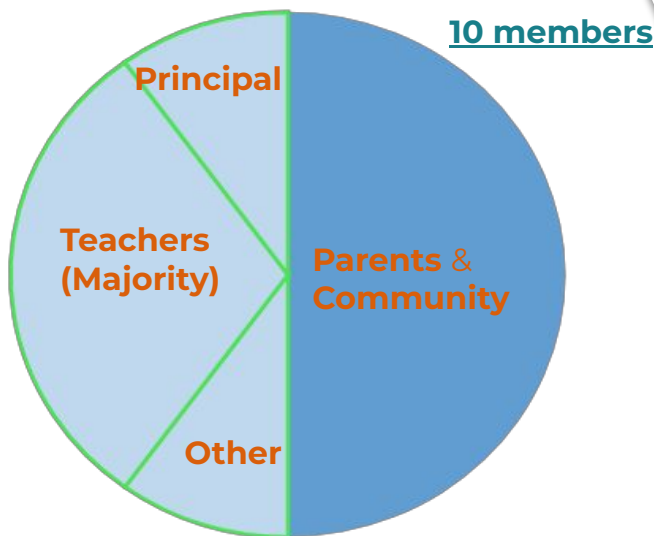

# Who is Involved?

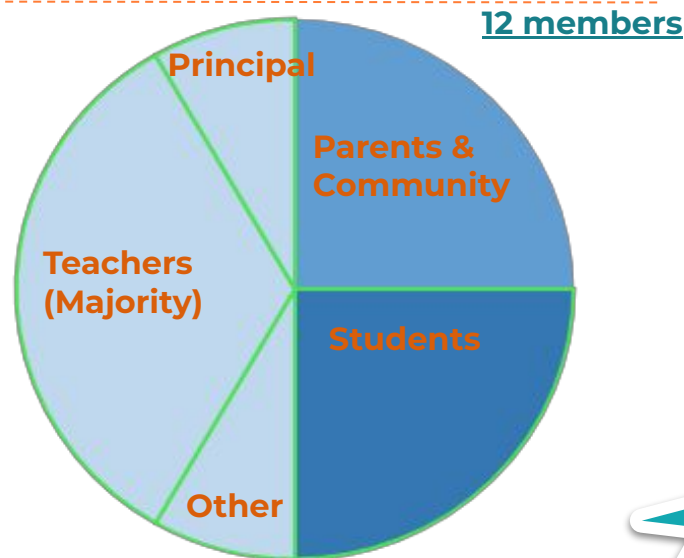

*As a committee, we revisit the past school plan. We look at the goals, the strategies, and resources. We reflect on the effectiveness.*



**We look at the data:**

- iReady, State, teacher created assessment results
- Attendance Rates
- Behavior Referrals



Based on the data results, we look at trends, past goals/resources and look at the effectiveness of plan. We then survey current needs, and begin to develop goals based on needs and data results.



*Align needs with resources to goals and strategies based on data results and changing needs.*



**Concurrently, Principals work collaboratively sharing needs, plans, goals, resources**

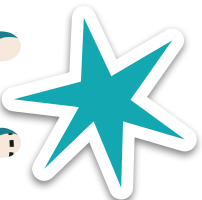
## SHARED DECISION MAKING AND ACCOUNTABILITY

With a defined plan, goals and resources aligned to needs, there is improvement in our practices





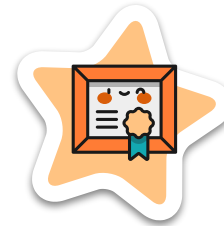
