For use in every subject students will need

- A pencil case or box with:
- □ Pens (blue, black, and red)
- □ White out pens. No correction tape.
- Pencils and erasers
- □ Highlighter pens (at least 2 colors)
- Scissors
- Glue stick

For daily use at school

- A standard school lock for locker (see below for the type of lock)
- Laptop charger
- □ Reusable water bottle (labelled with student's name)

For Mathematics/Science

 Scientific calculator capable of doing multiple exponents and roots. A good model available in Hong Kong is the <u>TI-34 Multi-View</u>, but any scientific calculator will work for the students. If you'd like to buy the TI-34 Mult-View, you can find it at the address below for approximately HK\$195. Please mention "CDNIS student" to get a discount. A graphing calculator is not needed until Grade 9.

For Health and Physical Education (HPE)

- □ PE kit to be carried in a drawstring bag to include:
- Top and shorts
- A hair tie for any hair longer than chin length
- Reusable water bottle
- Appropriate footwear (supportive and meant for physical exercise)

For Visual Arts

- A4 plain paper
- Eraser
- Pencils (2B and 6B)
- Gluesticks (2-3)

For Design

- Graph/grid paper (for technical drawings)
- Pencils (HB)
- Circle Compass
- Outlining pen (e.g pigment liner)

Locks we recommend the following type of locks since they do not break as easily. Please avoid key locks or digital locks. It must be a **combination lock** that can be closed even if the combination is not set.



- Please leave the combination sticker on the back of the lock so that we can record the combination
- Practicing with your child how to open and close the lock is a good idea; we will also do this at school
- Avoid TSA locks as the keys are widely available
