



Pink: Recently Renovated; Blue: Proposed Renovations







REQUIRED INFORMATION

CGHS PROJECT

- Estimated maximum par amount of bonds: \$45,000,000
- Maximum term of lease: 21 years
- Maximum term of bonds: 20 years
- Maximum annual lease payment: \$5,900,000
- Maximum total of all lease payments: \$82,795,000
- Total interest cost: \$37,388,038
- Most Recent Certified Rate: 2017 pay 2018 school Debt Service Fund levy (\$14,201,900) and rate (\$0.5721)
- Estimated Maximum Levy & Rate Following the Issuance of the Bonds: 2018 pay 2019 school Debt Service Fund levy (\$15,654,579) and rate (\$0.6020)
- Maximum Debt Service Rate for this project only (based on \$5,900,000 maximum annual lease rental and pay 2018 assessed value): \$0.2377
- Aggregate Maximum Annual Debt Service of the School Corporation as a percent of pay 2018 assessed value:
 0.50%
- Direct and Overlapping Debt as a percent of pay 2018 assessed value: 7.55%

Overall tax rate for the School Corporation will not increase due to the repayment of the bonds for this project. 19

FUNDING PROCESS

\$5 Million to \$15 Million: Remonstrance

- Opposition must collect required number of signatures.
- If enough signatures are collected:
 - Project goes to a remonstrance.
 - Each side has 30 days to collect the most signatures.

Above \$15 Million: Referendum

- Opposition must collect required number of signatures.
- If enough signatures are collected:
 - Project is placed on a ballot as a referendum. (The project passes if more people vote in favor of it.)

CGHS Project Impact

Project Without a Referendum


- School tax rate remains FLAT (less than \$1.04)
- Project design begins in January

Project With a Referendum

- Project payments move ABOVE the tax cap
- Project design will be delayed until May, with some increase in construction costs


CENTER GROVE SCHOOLS TAX RATE
