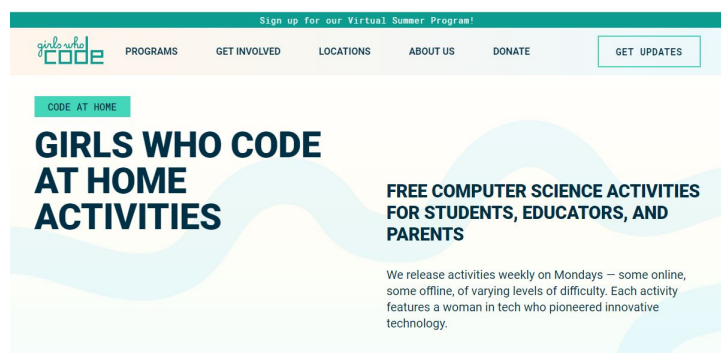
## Explore Summer at JCPL: Read for a Stronger Community
