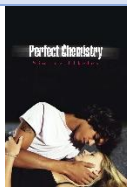

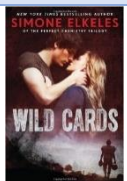

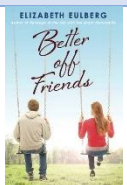

It is a truth universally acknowledged, that a single girl of high standing at Longbourn Academy must be in want of a prom date.

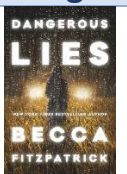
