SAFETY POLICY

The Board of Education believes that safety is important to everyone concerned with district schools, not only as a protective measure during school hours, but also as an instructional means of encouraging an appropriate mode of behavior to minimize accidents at all times. The Board recognizes that the safety of students, employees and the public is paramount in all school operations; all students, employees, and the public are to comply with all safety laws and/or ordinances. All employees are responsible for safety and are obligated to report health and safety hazards or unsafe conditions to the Building Principal or Supervisor in a timely manner.

The Superintendent or his/her designee shall have discretion to take the necessary steps and to develop guidelines to carry out the intent of this policy.
