What is Kami?

Kami is a web tool that allows teachers and students to edit PDF documents quickly and easily. Students will need the Kami Chrome Extension in order to work with Kami. Teachers can also create assignments for students in Google Classroom that will automatically open in Kami! This allows them to access the editing tools that they need, and submit the assignment directly.
