REPORT CARD INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

How and when grades are shared

Middle School

- Classes at this level are both quarter and semester lengths.
- For single-quarter classes, students will be given a final grade at the end of the quarter.
- For semester-long classes, students will receive a grade for each quarter and then a final semester grade that is an average of the two quarters.
- Throughout the quarter/semester grades on individual assignments and an overall percentage can be found on PowerSchool.
- At the middle school level there is not an official “report card” to view, rather PowerSchool shows the final grades in each class under “Grades and Attendance.”

High School

- Classes are semester-long, with a final grade given at the end of each semester.
- Throughout the semester grades on individual assignments and an overall percentage can be found on PowerSchool.
- At the high school level there is not an official “report card” to view, rather PowerSchool shows the final grades in each class under “Grades and Attendance.”

Timelines

1st Semester: August - December

1st Quarter: August - mid-October

2nd Quarter: Mid-October - December

2nd Semester: January - May

3rd Quarter: January - mid-March

4th Quarter: Mid-March - May

How to access grades

Parents can view current grades in the PowerSchool Parent Portal under Grades and Attendance at any time.

1. If you have more than one student, select the student tab for the student you want to view.
2. Click on Grades and Attendance in the left navigation menu as seen below.
3. To see individual assignments for each class click on the blue grade.
