**AHERA ANNUAL NOTICE  
CROWN POINT COMMUNITY SCHOOL CORPORATION**

This information is being published to comply with the requirements of 40 CFR 763, Subpart E, Asbestos Containing Materials in Schools. This regulation, commonly known as the "AHERA" rule, requires local education agencies, such as this one, to perform certain tasks in regards to the presence and control of asbestos-containing materials (ACMs) in the buildings under the jurisdiction of the local education agency.

These include but are not limited to:

1. Developing an asbestos management plan which is designed to outline procedures and guidelines for the initial inspection, triennial re-inspections, and 6-month periodic surveillance of ACMs that are present in the buildings.
2. Provide awareness training and additional training to selected school employees.
3. Periodically notify all workers and occupants, or their local guardians, parent teacher organizations, and collective bargaining organizations of the availability of asbestos management plans, the location of same and the times that the plans may be reviewed.

This notification is to advise all patrons, occupants, or their legal guardians, collective bargaining organizations, and parent-teachers organizations, that the asbestos management plans required under this act are available for review upon request. The plans can be viewed by any person during normal business hours of the particular school. Interested parties wishing to inquire about the plans should contact the individual school office. Master copies of the plans for all buildings under the jurisdiction of this local education agency are available in the Support Service Center in the Buildings and Grounds Department, which is located at 1151 East Summit Street, Crown Point, Indiana 46307; telephone number (219) 663-5701. Inquiries regarding any facet of the regulation or the management plans should be directed to Mr. Mike Malaski at the above telephone number during regular business hours.

Crown Point Community School Corporation school facilities and buildings which contain ACMs and must comply with the 40 CFR 763, Subpart E (AHERA) regulations include:

**Taft Middle School, MacArthur, Eisenhower, Winfield, Lake Street, Solon Robinson, and Timothy Ball Elementary Schools, Administration Service Center, and the Support Service Center.**

In preparation for the current renovation/demolition projects, these buildings have been thoroughly inspected for ACMs that may be affected during the renovation and/or demolition work. Management and removal of ACMs will or have been properly performed using State of Indiana licensed project designers, inspectors, management planners, supervisors, workers and contractors. Air monitoring will be performed during and after all abatement work to ensure the air quality meets the AHERA requirements for clearance and re-occupancy. Upon conclusion of the abatement/renovation projects, the management plans will be updated.

School facilities and buildings that are asbestos free and require no surveillance or re-inspection are:

**Crown Point High School, the new Taft Middle School, the new Administrative Service Center, Colonel John Wheeler Middle School, and Jerry Ross Elementary**
