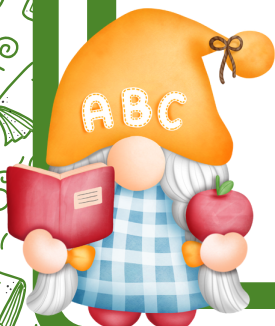

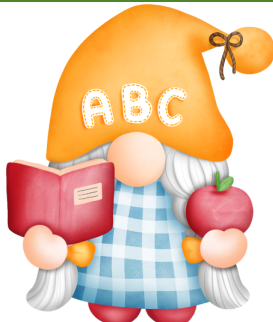


Parent Portal & Communication
