We are looking for children who display these skills most of the time.



Preschool Teachers & Staff



All of our classes are taught by licensed Preschool Intervention Specialists. Each classroom also has a extensively trained paraprofessional to assist in classroom learning. We also have a speech-language pathologist, occupational therapist, and physical therapist that visit the classrooms. We also partner with multiple outside agencies including Licking County Board of Developmental Delays and World of Wonderment for our wrap-around-care.
