

College Planning Calendar

Junior Year: You should be narrowing down the list of colleges to which you plan to apply. Visit the schools on your list.

September – December → College admissions representatives visit PHS during the school year. Sign up in the guidance office for the visits that interest you.

Senior Year: *August/September* → Apply to colleges. Get letters of recommendation as needed.

September – December → College admissions representatives visit PHS during the school year. Sign up in the guidance office for the visits that interest you. Even if you have already applied to a particular school, come to the visit. It's always good for the college admissions representative to be able to put a face to a name!

October → Start your scholarship search. See our counselor for a list of resources.

October 14 → Parent Information Night. 7pm in the high school auditorium.

October 1 – March 1 → The window for completing and submitting the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

February 17, 2015 → FAFSA Completion workshop. 5-7pm in the high school computer lab.

March/April → Award letters begin arriving. See your counselor if you have questions about paying for college and what your award letter means.

May 1st → National Decision Day. By May 1st, you should have notified the college of your choice that you will be attending and have paid any deposits needed.

May → Keep yourself on track for graduation! Colleges will see your final grades – don't let "senioritis" impact your future!
