

# RESTRUCTURING AT MCI . . .

## **ROSALIE WILLIAMS**

During the past three years, MCI has been one of nine Maine schools involved in a state-wide program aimed at supporting educational assessment and change. Each of the nine schools will determine what skills, values, and knowledge are needed to prepare its students for life in the Twenty-First Century and what strategies are likely to produce the desired results. To support this work, the State Department of Education, through its Innovative Grant Program, has awarded MCI two annual grants of \$10,000 each. These grants have allowed MCI to expand its programs of professional development, acquire a library of professional publications, and continue educational initiatives such as the LIFE Skills Program, which was instituted more than two years ago for MCI's freshman classes. My classroom responsibility has been reduced so that I may coordinate and support such program initiatives.

In addition to LIFE Skills, MCI's Humanities Department has restructured the curriculum in order to offer all MCI students a Humanities



course. Each Humanities course, although materials and methods may vary, offers an interdisciplinary study of English, history, and fine arts. The expanded Humanities Department is headed by Ronald Bessey.

Recognizing the central role of technology in world today, MCI has now made two fully equipped writing labs available to all students. Usage increases weekly.

Eisenhower funds, Chapter II monies, and a recent Tech-Prep grant for \$5,000, as well as the Annual Fund, have lent financial support to restructuring efforts. The Tech-Prep grant will help to fund an interdisciplinary applied math and science course which will be implemented for juniors and seniors in the fall of '93.

Preparing MCI for the future demands the participation of all constituencies of the school. We must assess our needs, reflect on our options for meeting those needs, be willing to change when necessary, and maintain a moral and financial commitment to educational excellence.

# A Report from the Director of Guidance . . .

### **DOUGLAS FERGUSON**

During this busy school year, the Guidance Department has responded to the varied needs of our students. The Department has worked closely with students to provide career information and college placement advice. Our staff has also dealt with many social issues, including teen promiscuity and pregnancy, alcohol and drug abuse, AIDS education, teen suicide, and self-esteem.



With the addition of Guidance Counselor Jane McMorrow to our staff, all members of MCI's Guidance Department have taken on different duties. School Registrar Debra Billings has assumed the responsibility of advising our postgraduate students about colleges. Mrs. Billings also advises all students about financial aid and scholarships. Sarah Ramgren has moved to a full-time position as the Guidance Secretary. Mrs. McMorrow and I serve as counselors, working with the same classes throughout their MCI years.

The Guidance Department offers several programs designed to help students cope with the myriad of problems they face. At present, several teen peer groups meet each week with the objective of achieving individual goals through group counseling. The Peer Helpers are MCI students who are trained in communication skills and teen problems. These students listen to their peers and make appropriate referrals for counseling services. Another teen program, one that offers academic support, is peer tutoring. Students who do well in academic coursework help those who are having difficulties. Mrs. McMorrow and I provide individual counseling services for students who cannot receive counseling outside of school. Students who are affected by substance abuse are referred to Linda Hale, a Registered Substance Abuse Counselor employed by Eastern Maine Counseling and Testing.

One of the new programs initiated this year was AIDS Awareness Day. Students and the public were invited to an assembly presented by the Eastern Maine AIDS Network. The students viewed informational films and met in small groups with guest speakers. Another new program this year was Career Day, a day-long fair featuring representatives of businesses who shared information with students about various career options.

Seniors and Postgraduates have been busy applying to colleges; many have been accepted to schools such as Marlboro College, Plymouth State College, various campuses of the University of Maine and the University of Massachusetts, Houghton College, Norwich University, Massachusetts Maritime Academy, Eastern Maine Technical College, Kennebec Valley Technical College, Lafayette College, Fayetteville State University, Iowa State University, and Villanova University. Parents and students are welcome to visit the Guidance Department at any time of the year. The office is open during school vacations; staff members are available to talk with anyone with questions about college placement.

Academic planning for classes in the 1993-1994 school year is underway. As our students meet with couselors to plan their schedules, the staff in the Guidance Department looks forward to another productive school year.

# MCI ATHLETICS . . .

# WALDO COVELL, Athletic Director



The summary/preview of the year in MCI athletics begins with the highlight of the fall season, our golf team's State Championship in Class B. The team, coached by Kyle Ladd, came in with a lower team score than the State Class A winner, Morse High School of Bath.

The girls' soccer team made the Eastern Maine play-offs, won its quarterfinal match, then lost to Camden/Rockport in the semifinals by one goal. Senior forward Mandy King received an outstanding honor by being chosen to the All American Team sponsored by the National Soccer Coaches Association and Umbro.

Despite posting the first losing season in five years with a 5-7 record, the postgraduate football team made athletic history of sorts by playing three weekend double-headers as part of its 12-game schedule. The double-headers were necessitated by increased squad size. An easy win of 42-24 over arch-rival Bridgton Academy was some consolation for the team's season record.

The end of the winter sports season saw MCI's cheering squad place fourth in the Eastern Maine Class B tournament. With this placement, the squad was chosen for the State tournament.

The ski team completed a successful season with junior Caroline Wright winning both Class B slalom and giant slalom events. With this achievement and a strong finish in cross country competition, Caroline earned the State Skimeister Trophy.

In rifle team meets, MCI won the State Championship in the prone division. Peter Logidice was named the State Prone Champion.

Wrestlers Jason Watrous and Rutledge King won State Championships in their weight classes in Class C competition. They both took part in an open state tournament on February 20th in which King placed third and Watrous, fourth.

Girls' basketball finished fifth in Eastern Maine and was eliminated by Ellsworth in the first round of the Eastern Maine Tournament. Coach Julie Treadwell's team accomplished this without the services of Senior Mandy King and with only one other senior in the starting combination.

Coach Max Good's postgraduate basketball team won the New England Prep School Tournament this winter for the third time in four years. The team's remarkable record over the four-year time span is 100-4. The tournament, which was held at the University of Southern Maine's Hill Gymnasium, saw MCI's team defeat Cheshire Academy, 100-74 and St. Thomas Moore School, 83-57.

A preview of spring sports finds boys' tennis the projected big winner. Last spring, the team made it to the semifinals in Eastern Maine Class B; most of that squad will return to the team this year. Track and baseball will have re-building seasons after being hard hit by graduation in 1992. The softball team should be competitive again after winning the Eastern Maine Championship in 1992. Senior pitcher Becky Vaughan will return to lead the '93 Huskies.

# A Report from the Business Manager . . .

### FINANCIAL REPORTS

MCI is a non profit corporation that operates under specific Financial Accounting Standards. Independent auditors review all financial documentation annually and report on the condition of the school through the annual Auditors' Report.

Non profit schools report financial information on a Fund basis. There are three funds that are used to report financial information: Operating or General Fund, Plant Fund and Endowment Fund.

The **Operating** Fund consists of Unrestricted and Restricted Funds. The Unrestricted Fund is where all of the day-to-day financial transactions of the school occur, such as purchasing books, paying employees, or buying fuel to heat the buildings. The Restricted Fund includes the student club accounts (French Club, Drama Club, etc.), unrestricted scholarship principal and restricted scholarship earnings to be awarded during this fiscal year as scholarships, and grant awards used in this fiscal year.

Operating Fund Revenues and Expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1992, follow. Nearly 90% of MCI's revenues come from tuition and fees from S.A.D. #53 and our dormitory students. The Annual Giving Fund currently generates 2.53% of our revenues. Continued growth of the Fund is essential in order for MCI to maintain its current educational programs.


The **Plant** Fund consists of all of the material assets of the school — land, buildings and equipment; and all long-term debt owed by the school.

The **Endowment** Fund consists of monies given to MCI, where the principal portion of the gift is restricted. Any monies earned during the current fiscal year are directed to the appropriate fund. For example, interest earned from a \$50,000 endowed scholarship will be transferred to the Restricted Fund for use as a scholarship award. The \$50,000 gift remains intact, in the Endowment Fund, and earning more money for future scholarships.

### COMMITMENT TO PHYSICAL PLANT

MCI understands the importance of maintaining its land, buildings and equipment. Renovations, repair, and replacement are critical to the long-term success of any institution. We view these capital additions and expenditures as investing in the future of our students and our school.

In the past five years, MCI has replaced, repaired and renovated more than \$1.7 million of equipment and buildings. Many of these renovations were long overdue. From 1987 through 1989, MCI built Wright Gymnasium and renovated its dormitories. The projects done each year since then range from building two computer labs for the students, to removing asbestos in all buildings. The following graph depicts the dollars invested in our plant over the last 5 years. We are proud of these accomplishments. With your help we will be able to continue these worthwhile projects.



### **REVENUES**

Our commitment to maintaining and improving our entire campus has been possible as a result of Operating Fund Revenues during the years 1988 through 1992.
