Saturday's events began at 9 a.m. with registration in the library where many gathered to reminisce and visit with old friends. At 9:30 21 class agents met with Alumni Director Patricia Anderson to discuss plans for the coming year. Following the Class Agent Coffee, the annual business meeting of the Alumni Association took place. New officers were elected as follows: Sherman Lahaie '60, President; Ted Susi '70, Vice-President; and Patrick McGowan '74, Assistant Treasurer. During the afternoon all of the anniversary classes hosted special class gatherings. Members of the golden anniversary class of 1935 enjoyed a special luncheon on campus followed by a reception where they were presented with golden anniversary mugs and certificates. The 50-year class had been raising money for this special occasion, and they voted to present the school with the entire sum of \$2,364 to be used toward the purchase of computers for the school. The school was planning to purchase a few microcomputers this year, but this generous gift will allow MCI to buy a considerable amount of new equipment.

The day concluded with the annual reunion banquet held under a large canopy on the front campus. The oldest alumnus in attendance was Gladys Tarbell Shorey from the Class of 1912. It was a tossup as to who had travelled the furthest since a handful of people had made the trip from various parts of California, but there was no question as

to which class responded loudest to the roll call — it was definitely the class of 1965. Frances Buckley of Pittsfield won the rocking chair raffle.





Gym Construction to Begin

On Saturday, October 12, 1985, the MCI Board of Trustees met to discuss the items on the fall agenda, the most critical issue being that of the new gymnasium. The outcome of the meeting was the trustees' overwhelming decision to immediately begin constructing the new facility and continue with fundraising efforts. Acting upon the recommendation of the Budget/Finance Committee, the Board of Trustees decided against borrowing the money needed to complete the gym.

Prior to the fall meeting of the trustees, MCI had been approved for a Farmers Home Administration loan for up to \$650,000 to use along with what had been raised to date to complete the new gym. However, the Budget/Finance Committee unanimously decided that the school should not borrow the money. The committee felt that repaying a loan of that magnitude would be a terrible financial burden to MCI for years to come. Therefore, based on the strong recommendation of the Budget/Finance Committee, the trustees decided not to borrow any money but to begin construction on the gym.

The trustees voted to use the \$382,000 already raised, an amount which, according to Alton Cianchette '48, Chairman of the Gymnasium Committee, will provide enough money to build the shell, i.e., to complete the site preparation work, foundation, walls, and roof. The contractor for the project is Bowman and Littlefield, Inc., of Hartland, the low bidders when the gym went to bid in 1983. President of the Board of Trustees, David Higgins '51, is planning on the cost of the gym to be in excess of \$800,000, possibly closer to \$900,000. Says he, "It is my hope that we can raise enough additional funds to complete the interior of the gym, and we are currently working on plans to raise about \$500,000 more to do so. In



addition, approximately \$60,000 is due in pledges by the end of next year, all of which is expected to be paid. It is up to MCI's alumni and friends as to how soon the gym will be completed — we will be asking for their financial support."

"There is no question that our school is in need of a new gymnasium," commented Headmaster Ralph Baxter. "Our present facility is in use from early morning until late at night with many teams being cheated out of valuable gym time due to scheduling problems. When used in addition to Parks Gymnasium, the new facility will allow us to develop intramural programs, provide ample practice time for all our teams, and will provide the school and community with a place large enough to seat 800 people. The new gym will be located behind the library, between the roadway and the practice field. The plans call for a 17,400 square foot structure, a 9400 square foot gym floor, two-story boys' and girls' locker rooms, a training room, rest rooms, offices, a ticket booth, and storage areas. Depending upon the weather, site preparation and foundation work may begin this fall followed by

major construction in the spring. As donations come in, the work will proceed, and the trustees hope the construction will be an incentive for additional contributions."

They Made a Commitment . . .

Since the MCI Commitment Fund was initiated in 1980, almost \$1 million has been raised. Weymouth Hall was renovated at a cost of \$379,000; some \$41,400 in dormitory renovations were completed; and \$72,400 in architect's fees for the new gym were paid. Honoring their commitment to build the gym, the trustees have made the decision to start its construction, realizing that only half of the needed funds are in hand. MCI's 6500 alumni, its parents, and its friends will be asked to make a donation so the gym can be completed. They made a commitment . . . won't you?

\$25,000 Gift from Church Goods

Last February MCI received one of its most substantial contributions to the gym fund when Church Goods Manufacturing Company, Inc., of Pittsfield, donated \$25,000 to the project. Since their gift qualified for matching through the Wright Challenge Match, twice as much money was generated from their considerable

donation. Church Goods is the manufacturing and distribution center for C.M. Almy & Son, Inc., a company known nationwide for its quality clergy apparel and church decorations.

The president of the company, Ryan Fendler, sees the need for a new athletic facility at MCI and is pleased with the Edwards Company Extends Challenge

In June 1985 Robert N. Brooks, Vice-President of Operations at Edwards Company in Pittsfield, presented a check in the amount of \$13,000 to be used toward the construction of the new gym for MCI. Their generous donation was matched by Clifford and Carl Wright. In addition, Edwards Company pledged \$13,000 more as matching money towards "new" contributions received in 1986.

Beginning January 1, 1986, as soon as the new gym fund accumulates \$13,000 in new cash, Edwards Company will match that amount, bringing Edwards' total contribution to \$26,000. This matching money applies strictly to new contributions received after January 1, 1986, and does not apply to payments on pledges which were made prior to January 1.

Edwards Company, a unit of General Signal Corporation, manufactures and distributes electrical signaling and communication systems.

trustees' recent decision to begin building it. His son Michael, Vice-President of Manufacturing at Church Goods, attended MCI in the late sixties and has been very active as an alumnus of the school. Both Ryan and Michael are members of the MCI Board of Trustees.

Wright Challenge is Met

Due to intensified fundraising efforts on behalf of the trustees over the past year, close to \$100,000 in cash was raised, thereby successfully completing the Wright Challenge which was extended in February 1982. At that time Clifford '38 and Carl '43 Wright agreed to match all "new contributions" up to \$200,000, excluding payments toward pledges that were made prior to the announcement.

We take this opportunity to express our sincere appreciation to Clifford and Carl Wright — two extremely dedicated alumni who have devoted considerable amounts of energy, money, and time to the new gym project. Through their outstanding support, the Wrights have made it possible for MCI to build a new gymnasium. Generations for years to come can thank these two individuals for making it all possible.
