I. Public Forum

A TMISD parent, Esperanza Gonzales, requested permission to speak to the SHAC about the procedures used at TM-High School for evaluating/testing students who may be under the influence. Her concern was centered on the use of the word "testing" by Administration to determine whether her student was under the influence of marijuana. Rather, she argued that the use of the word "evaluating" should have been used instead. Ms. Gonzales finally recommended further training for nurses that focuses on the intake process and communication of findings to families.

Information Item(s)

a. 2022-2023 Terms of Service

The TMISD Committee Application will open on May 1 and close on May 30. Members with one years of service or less were encouraged to reapply. Members with two years of service were also encouraged to apply but that their application would only be given preference if meeting the stakeholder requirement was needed.

b. 2022-2023 TEA School Health Survey

The TEA announcement regarding the survey was discussed and that the survey would require collaboration among campus administrators and the appropriate personnel to complete. The required survey is due Friday, June 2, 2023.

c. 2022-2023 SHAC Annual Report

The report to the School Board and its reporting requirements were reviewed and discussed under the context of the activities completed for the current school year. The Annual Report is anticipated to be given to the School Board at the June 2023 regular board meeting.

b. 2022-2023 Student Engagement Survey

The survey has been divided into sections, each with an SEL focus. Students will complete the survey during the month of May, with the decision on when to complete the survey made by the principal of each campus.
