When will student schedules be available?

Student schedules will be available by August 1. Any schedule conflicts with requested courses will be addressed prior to the start of the school on August 14

We are currently on a seven-period schedule and students eat lunch during 5th period. The regular school day begins at 7:50 a.m. and ends at 2:40 p.m. On most Wednesdays the school day begins at 8:30 a.m.

What time does the school building open each day? How late is it open?

The school building is open from 7:00 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. daily.

How much is the school lunch?

Lunch prices will not be available until late summer. As an alternative to the main entrée, various cold boxed lunch options are also available. For students that want to pack their lunch or purchase additional items, sandwiches, snacks and drinks are also available.
