- Voluntary pre-kindergarten was established by Governor Dayton and the 2016 Minnesota Legislature to prepare children for success as they enter kindergarten the following year.
- To be eligible for this free preschool program you must reside within Kennedy or Washington Elementary boundaries
- Child must be <u>4 years old</u> by September 1
- Cannot be age eligible to attend kindergarten (5)
- Transportation is available for those who qualify
