



## 2022-2023 Covid-19 Learning Plan

**District Goal** - To manage the Covid-19 pandemic and keep our schools fully open.

**Leading Guidance** - The district thoroughly analyzed the guidance for public schools published by the CDC and fully adopted by IDPH and ISBE. The district also received consultation from the ROE, other regional districts, LUDA (Large Unit District Association), and the Rock Island Co. Health Dept.

**Recommendations** - The following recommendations for Covid-19 health and safety are *subject to change at any time*. Layered mitigations can be added or eliminated at any time based on local positivity rates, vaccination percentages, or other key factors.

MCV Covid-19 Health and Safety <i>Suggested</i> Guidelines	
<b>Face Coverings</b>	Face coverings will remain a personal choice at this time.
<b>Personal Hygiene</b>	All staff and students will be reminded to wash hands or use sanitizer when washing is not available. Staff and students will also be reminded to stay home when sick.
<b>Air-Quality and Ventilation</b>	<p>The District has embarked on an aggressive plan to improve air quality and ventilation. Through strategic Cares and American Rescue Plan dollars, the District is installing new HVAC systems in 5 elementary schools and one early childhood center.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>→ 2022 Jane Addams Elementary School</li> <li>→ 2022 Butterworth Elementary School</li> <li>→ 2022 Logan Elementary School</li> <li>→ 2023 Washington Elementary School</li> <li>→ 2023 Lincoln-Irving Elementary School</li> <li>→ 2023 Jefferson Early Childhood Center</li> </ul>
<b>Cleaning and Sanitizing</b>	MCV will continue with thorough cleaning and sanitizing of high touch surfaces, including the use of BioTech fogging in all schools, as needed.
<b>Quarantine Protocols</b>	<p>For students who have tested positive:</p> <p><b>At home</b> for <b>5</b> days from the date of the positive test. The student may return after the 5th day, granted the student is asymptomatic or showing improved symptoms (24 hours without vomiting/diarrhea and fever free without the use of fever reducing medications). <i>If symptoms not improving, must stay home 10 days.</i></p>

<b>Instruction during Quarantine</b>	<p><u>For Elementary Students</u> Students in grades K-1 will be able to track their learning activities for the day through SeeSaw.</p> <p>Students in grades 2-5 will be able to track their learning activities for the day through Google Classroom.</p> <p><u>For Secondary Students</u> Students in grades 6-12 will be able to track their assignments and activities through Google Classroom.</p>
<b>Testing</b>	MCV encourages all symptomatic staff and students to be tested for Covid-19 by a healthcare provider.
<b>Vaccination Promotion</b>	The district has hosted 15 days of free vaccination clinics for students and staff over the past two years.
