








All Accountability Reading Proficiency by Grade











The Indicators



Academic Achievement

The number of students at the "Meets Standards" or "Exceeds Standards" achievement levels divided by all students in tested grades. Calculated separately for **math** and **reading**.



Progress Toward English Language Proficiency

The average progress English learners made toward individual growth targets on the ACCESS for ELLs test.



Academic Progress

A score based on students' achievement levels from one year to the next. Calculated separately for **math** and **reading**.



Graduation Rates

The percentage of students who graduated in four years and seven years.




Consistent Attendance






The ACCESS Assessment



Three-digit scale score (such as 235) converted to a proficiency level (such as 3.1), based on the student's grade.


Proficiency = Composite proficiency level of 4.5 and at least three domains at 3.5 or above.




Graduation



If a student drops out after less than half an academic year at a high school, they will be counted as a dropout in the graduation rate of whichever high school they have attended for the most time




























Percent of AP Students with Scores 3+
