Parents/Guardians of 11th grade students:

Hope this message finds you well! Your student is almost halfway through their junior year and looking toward 12th grade and graduation. During the 11th grade year the state of Pennsylvania requires that each student have a physical examination. If your student has a family doctor, please take the form, linked here, to your appointment and return it as soon as possible. If your child does not have a family doctor, or it would be a hardship, school physicals will be offered by our school physicians, at no cost, at a later date. Along with the physical exam, a second Meningococcal vaccination is required for entrance into 12th grade. This vaccination is typically given at the 11th grade exam. Proof of this vaccination must be received by the 1st day of your student's senior year. Please click here for more information on immunizations.
