## PURPOSE OF THE FOUNDATION

The Lowellville School Foundation was established by the Lowellville Board of Education to improve the education of Lowellville students by providing educational resources for curriculum enrichment and for scholarships following graduation.

The Board of Directors was formed to manage the Foundation. The Lowellville Board of Education has the option to match all or part of donations to the Foundation according to Foundation policies. Foundation funds cannot be used for operating expenses of the school district.

## MISSION STATEMENT

The Lowellville School Foundation is dedicated to enhancing the educational opportunities available to Lowellville students. Our Foundation actively encourages and supports improvements in the school's academic performance and overall operations.

# SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Scholarships are awarded to graduating seniors who have attended Lowellville High School from their freshman through senior year. Scholarship payments are sent directly to the technical school, college, or university of the student's choice and are for tuition only. Therefore, a student who has received an all tuition paid scholarship from another source is not eligible for the **Lowellville School Foundation** Scholarship and will not be included in the selection process from the time knowledge of the other scholarship is received.

Scholarship recipients are selected by the members of the **Lowellville School Foundation** Board of Directors based on a point system for the following categories:

1. grade-point averages;
2. ACT scores;
3. school related extra-curricular activities;
4. a written essay and
5. a personal interview with two members of the Board of Directors.

The applications received by the Foundation Board for review do not contain the name of the student so that the decision process can be as objective as possible. Once the points are calculated to determine which students are to be interviewed, those applications are forwarded to the Guidance Counselor to notify the students and to schedule the interviews with members of the **Lowellville School Foundation** Board.

Following the interviews, all members of the **Lowellville School Foundation** meet to discuss the interviews and to make the final determination of how many scholarships to award and the total scholarship amount. The students receive the award at the Senior Breakfast.
